


Sūryōdaya means sunrise in Marathi, the language of the Indian state of Maharashtra. It is there that Sister Lucy Kurien founded her first home for women who were victims of abuse and trauma in 1997. The institution MAHER (Marathi for "House of Mothers," in the sense of "a home"), is now an UN-registered NGO. Today, it operates around 70 interfaith homes for people in need and those seeking protection across India.


During my visits to several MAHER homes in Maharashtra, I invited the women living there to draw with me in the mornings after sunrise. These were light-filled, joyful hours we spent together.
